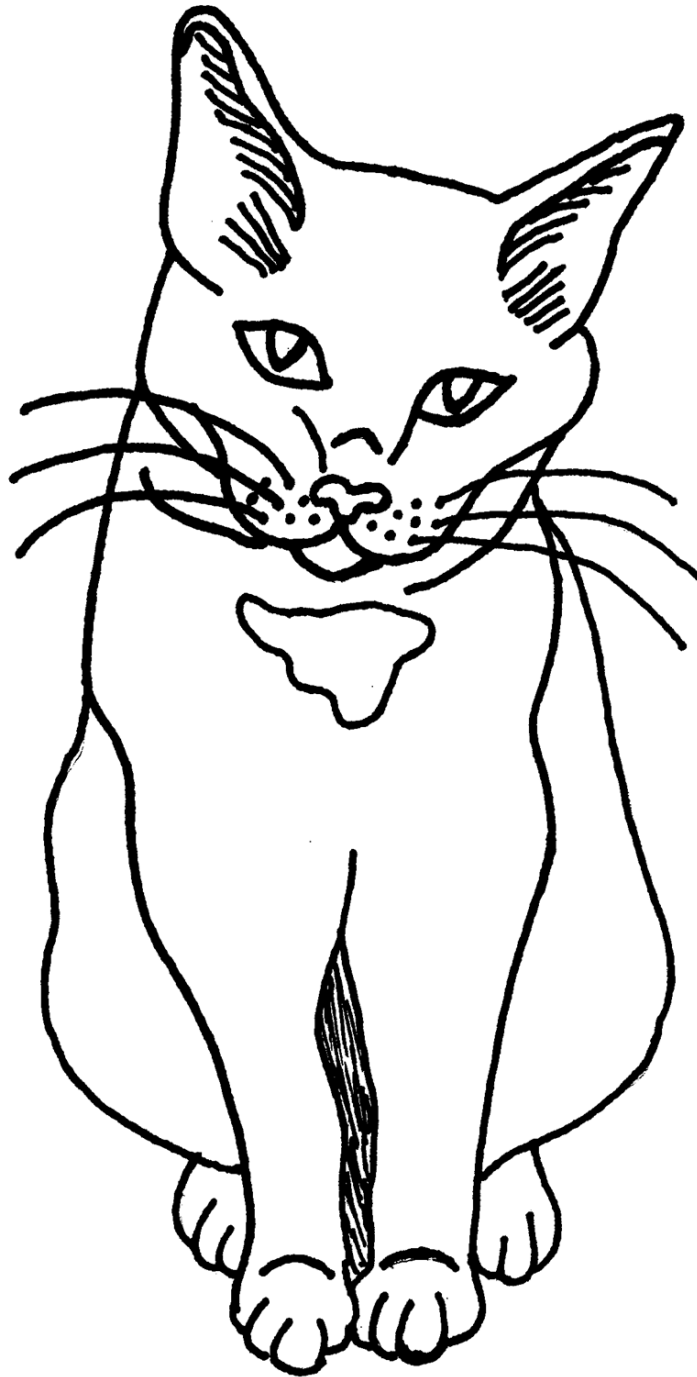
Check out our craft pages for fun ideas to make to share with pets in need, or make them for your own pets. There are also ideas for the people in your life who love animals, too!

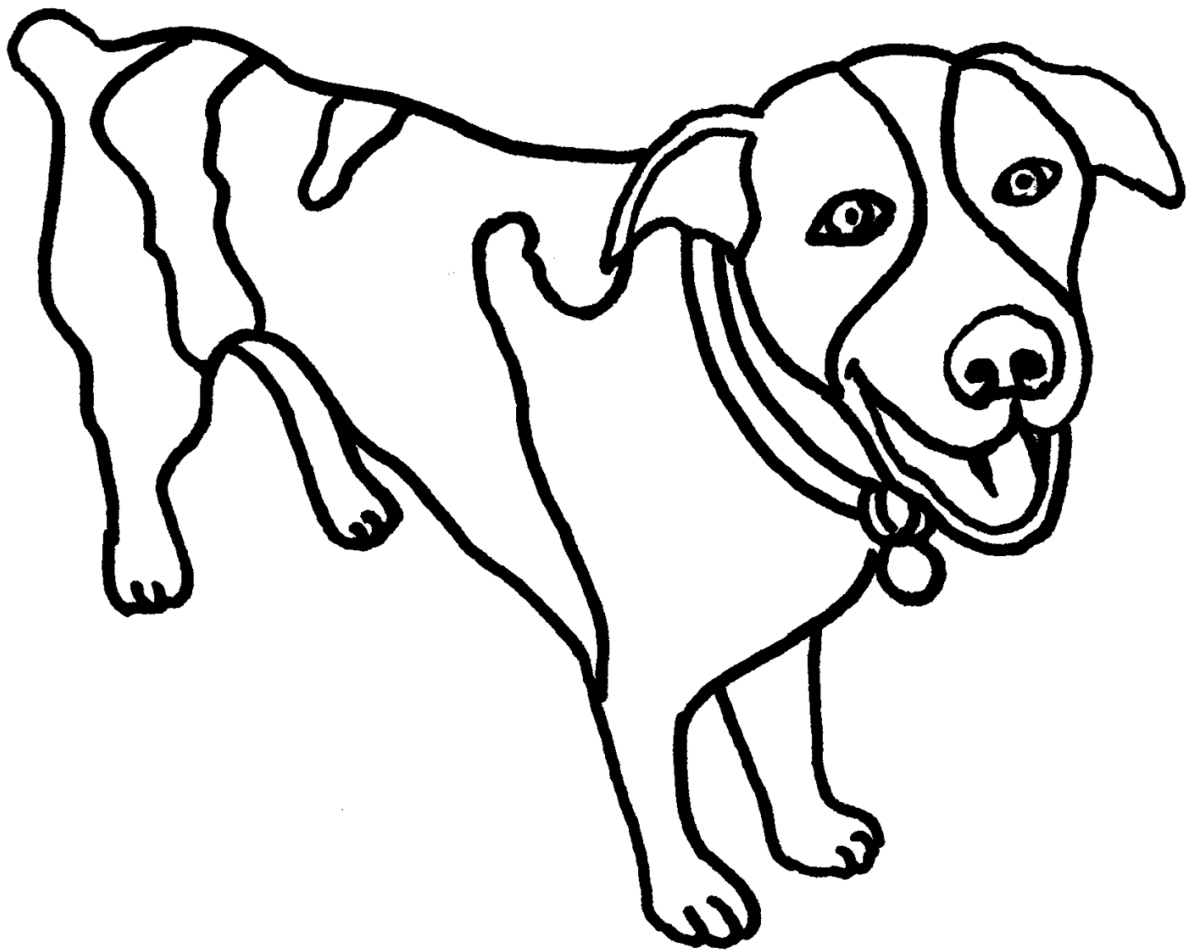

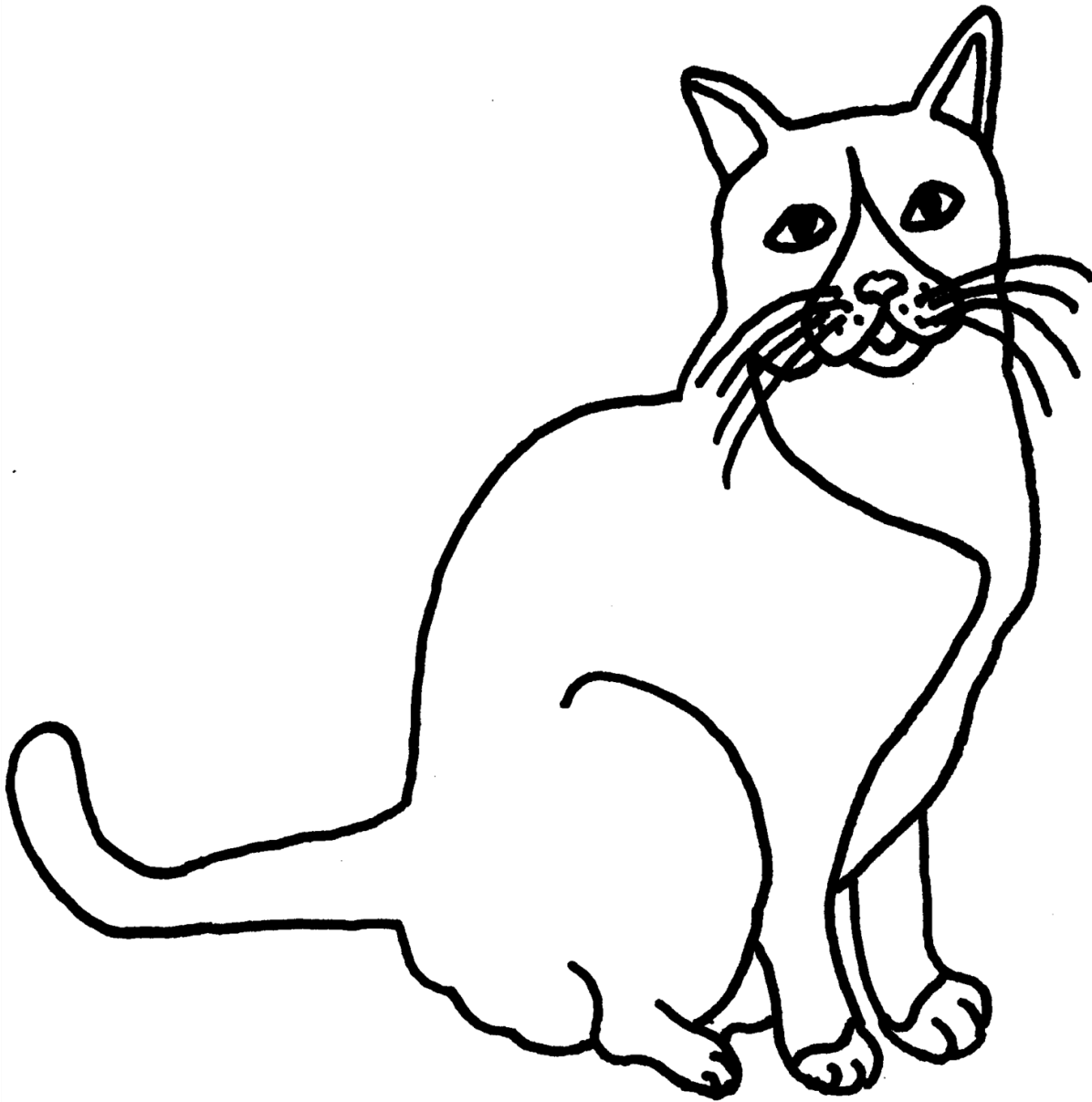
It's important for your dog to have a collar and tag with his name, address and phone number. If he gets lost, anyone who finds your dog will know where he belongs.



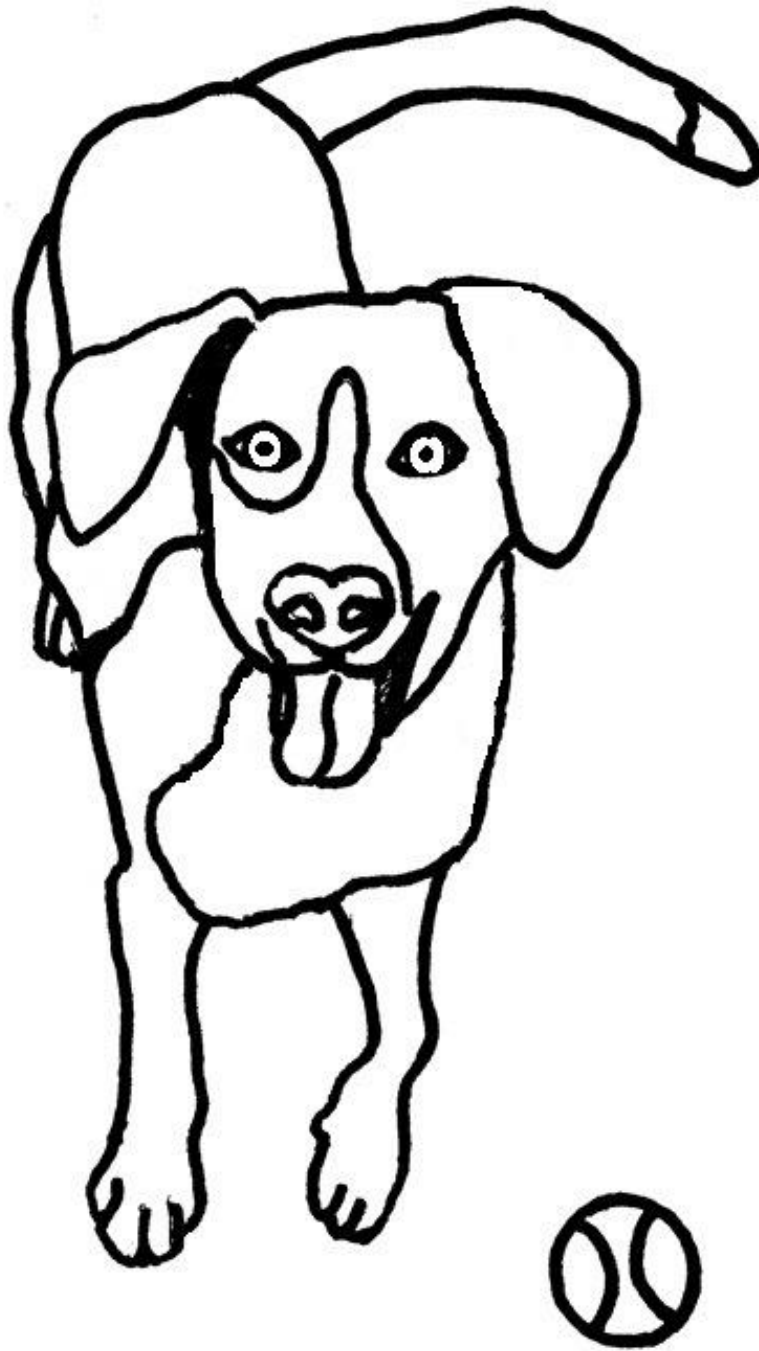
Like most cats and kittens, Chloe loves to play. Playing with your cat is a great way to bond with her, and a great way for your new cat to get daily exercise.
